



Mentoring for Success Program



Overview

The Food and Agribusiness Network (FAN) has created the Mentoring for Success program to assist small FAN member companies to address a challenge or opportunity within their businesses, by providing access to experienced and skilled mentors.

The mentee will complete a questionnaire about their business, which will be provided to up to six mentors to review. The mentee will then attend a 1-hour meeting with the mentors, who will ask questions and provide their views. At the end of this meeting, the mentee will be assigned a mentor who they will work with over a six-month period. This service will be based on a 10-minute phone call (or equivalent) per week.

Eligibility

- | Must be a member of FAN
- | Turnover under \$1.5 million
- | Participants need to be prepared to provide information about their business such as financials, business plan, key challenges, value proposition etc.

Who are our mentors?

Mentors are other FAN members who have been successful in growing their business and are willing to provide their time, knowledge and expertise in a voluntary capacity. Mentors cannot be consultants and all mentors will sign confidentiality agreements.
